Kaena was launched in 2001 to showcase owner and winemaker Mikael's deep passion for winemaking, especially using his favorite varietal Grenache. Mikael who is part Hawaiian and raised on the Oahu shores, uses a shortened version of his given name for the brand - Kaena - which means "potential for greatness". That "greatness" is evident in the wines - in 2006 Wine Spectator named Mikael one of the top 10 new Rhone producers. Known affectionately by his peers and fans as The Grenache King - Kaena produces 5000 cases of Rhone & other varietals with an emphasis on Grenache.

Winemaking

28% Syrah, 19% Grenache, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Tempranillo, 11% Petit Verdot, 6% Malbec, 5% Merlot, 4% Sangiovese.

Hapa Red was born from Mikael's admiration for the wines of Spain's Priorat region, renowned for their intricate blends of Rhone and Bordeaux varietals. These wines are celebrated for their remarkable complexity, depth, and character.

Tasting Notes

Dark aromas of currant, blackberry, and boysenberry, along with scents of sandalwood, vanilla, graphite, chocolate, and leather. Rich upfront flavors of blackberry, currant, and grenadine lead to a lush core filled with chocolate, leather, coffee, molasses and bakers spice, finishing with complex chewy tannins. Age for 3 to 12 years.
